


# Wendover

– Open Water

Where to Stay: I stay at Best Western Wendover.

When: 11am Saturday (Boise time) - I'll drive down Saturday morning.

Where: Arby's (in Wendover)



Sunday: Meet at the lake at 9:00 or at the Best Western at 8:30.

What you need:

#### Clothes

In Wendover, the weather is a bit unpredictable. Some days it's calm and sunny, some days it rains, some days the wind blows across the desert. Bring clothes for a Cold day, a Warm day, and a Rainy day. As well, pack an extra jacket, a blanket and a couple of towels.

#### Equipment

3 tanks per person.

Wetsuit (upper and lower)

Weight (extra weight as well)

Regulator

BCD (with Submersible Pressure Gauge, depth gauge, timing device. Or, dive computer)

Fins/mask/snorkel/boots

#### Other

Dive Log (this can be a normal notebook, or one with specialized dive log pages)

Tarp on which to put all your gear together to keep dirt off your equipment.

#### Food

Diving takes a lot of energy.

Bring something for lunch.

Bring snacks.

Bring a lot of water.

#### The Lake

Blue lake is geothermally heated from the bottom. It's approximately 60 feet deep with several platforms and many things for divers to explore. Water temperature is 65 -78 degrees year round. (I'll tend to wear a wetsuit upper and be just fine). However, the walk back to the cars is generally cold. The lake / parking lot / etc. is covered by a fine layer of silt on the bottom that can get stirred up. It gets everywhere. Use a tarp.

It's about a 100 yard walk from parking to the entry.
